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2012 GENERAL INFORMATION

NINETY THIRD SEASON

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The tuition fee covers all normal expenditures: board, lodging, laundry, transportation from and to the Nashville Airport, special trips, equipment in all activities, instruction and supervision by a staff of competent counselors, and also the services of the Camp Infirmary including our camp physician. In the unlikely event of an accident or illness requiring a trip to one of our local physicians or specialists, or the need for a prescription while at camp, our office will call you for additional information to pay for health care services. We will forward the necessary paperwork so that you can submit the claim to your insurance for reimbursement.

ADMISSION Nakanawa is open to girls of good character between the ages of 8 and 17. The two week session is open to girls that are 8 to 14 and have completed grades two through eight. The four week session is open to girls that are 8 to 17 and have completed grades two through eleven. Each girl is expected to conform to the rules and regulations of Nakanawa and the guidelines set forth by each team. We expect our girls to be loyal campers and to cooperate with the Directors and camp personnel. We do not allow smoking, profanity, alcohol or drugs other than those prescribed by a doctor. The Directors reserve the right to dismiss any girl or deny admission to any applicant who, in our opinion, is deemed undesirable or whose presence would be detrimental to the best interest of Nakanawa. In the event of dismissal or withdrawal for any reason, no part of the camp fee will be refunded, except when withdrawal is advised by a physician. Girls who will be eight years old before July 1 and have completed grades 2nd-5th are eligible for admission to Junior Camp for the two week session. Girls who have completed grades 6th-8th will be eligible for Intermediate Camp for the two week session. Girls who have completed grades 2nd-6th will be eligible for Junior Camp for the four week session. Girls who have completed grades 7th-8th will be eligible for Intermediate Camp for the four week session. Girls who have completed grades 9th-11th will be eligible for Senior Camp for the four week session. Should there be any question as to which camp will be most suitable for a camper, it would be best to discuss placement with the Directors before reaching a decision.

INSURANCE A copy of your insurance card (front and back) along with the policy holder's name, birth date and social security number is required and must be included with this completed Application and with the Medical Form that will be sent to you in March.

SISTERS A discount of 10% of the total tuition for each sister enrolled will be allowed.

SPENDING MONEY The suggested amount to give your daughter is \$10.00 per week. This would be used for items sold in the Commissary such as shampoo, soap, toothpaste, film, stationery or stamps if needed. All snacks, drinks, trips are included in the tuition fee and an order form for clothing items will be sent with the Letter of Final Instructions. This money is kept by the camper.

TRANSPORTATION AND BAGGAGE Campers may arrive by car or plane. Campers arriving by plane will be met in the Nashville Airport. Trunks and duffle bags must be sent ahead by FEDEX or UPS or it can accompany the camper by car. All returning baggage must be sent by car, FEDEX or UPS. The only exceptions are International Campers baggage. Airline Flights must fly into/out of Nashville, Tennessee and arrive/depart between 8:00am and 1:00pm CDT on opening/closing day of session. Written permission is required if camper is returning home with anyone other than legal guardian or parent. All baggage that is shipped must be in a box to be insured.

EATABLES FORBIDDEN Since the primary purpose of a summer camp is to provide a healthy environment, Nakanawa requests that campers receive no eatables of any kind while in attendance at camp. Fresh fruit, fruit juices, yogurt, milk, and graham crackers are available at designated times each morning and afternoon. The camp diet is carefully planned and is nutritious in quality, varied and appetizing. Counselors and campers who have attended Nakanawa in past years will bear testimony to the excellence of the meals served at camp.

SPECIAL DIETARY NEEDS All special dietary needs must be acknowledged by a licensed Physician with a written request to the camp and then approved by the directors. Supplemental foods requested by doctor will be kept in the Commissary. Any possible menu substitutions, questions or concerns should be discussed with the directors prior to May 1st. Menu will be posted on web site.

CATHOLIC MASS Our campers of Catholic faith have the convenience of attending Mass in Junior Camp during the Two Week Session and Senior Camp during the Four Week Session. The service is held at 7:00am Sunday morning with the Priest from Crossville officiating. Please indicate on the application if you daughter will attend. Changes cannot be made after the camp season begins.

TELEPHONE Our telephone number is 931-277-3711 and our FAX number is 931-277-5552. We do not allow campers to receive phone calls, to make phone calls or to send faxes. Cell phones are not permitted and if brought to camp will be stored in the camp office.

PARENTAL VISITS Parents and visitors are welcome at Nakanawa. We request that you defer your visit until after the first week of both sessions. June 23rd will be the first visiting day during the two week session and July 9th will be the first visiting day during the four week session. The best time to visit is during Rest Hour from 1:30–3:30pm CDT(arrive at 1:30pm; no food, drink or cell phone to be shared). Please visit on the Games Field away from the cabin areas where the other campers and counselors will be resting. Parents of our Two Week Campers are invited to join us for the Buffet, Musical and Awards Presentation on Friday, June 29th. Parents of our Four Week Campers are invited to join us for the Operetta, Fine Arts Program, Buffet and Trophy Night on Saturday, July 28th. Reservations are required for the Buffets.

LAUNDRY is sent on a weekly basis and the fee is included in the tuition. For the two week session it is sent out on the first Friday and returned on Saturday. During the four week session in Junior it is sent out on Monday and returned on Wednesday; in Senior it is sent out on Wednesday and returned on Friday.
